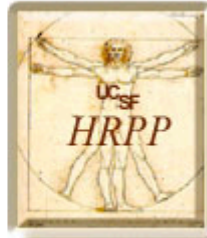

Updated Online Training Program - Requirement for all Key Personnel (PIs, Co-PIs and other Key Personnel) Listed in CHR Applications

The online UCSF Human Research Protection Training Program has been replaced with the nationally recognized and widely used online training program called the [Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative](#) (CITI). As of **March 1, 2009**, all UCSF **Key Personnel** conducting human research will be required to complete the online CITI training. The prior training is no longer valid for the CHR and Contracts and Grants.
